In accordance with the MCA Circulars, SEBI circulars and Regulation 44 of the SEBI Listing Regulations, as amended, this Postal Ballot Notice is being sent to all the shareholders whose name is recorded in the Register of Members or in the Register of Beneficial Owners maintained by the Depositories as on Cut-off date i.e. April 4, 2025 through email or physical as the case may be. Further, if your e-mail address is not registered with the Company/Depositories, please follow the process provided in the Notes to receive this Postal Ballot Notice.

The proposed Resolution and the Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Act, setting out the material facts and reasons thereof, are appended to this Postal Ballot Notice. The Board of Directors of the Company, through Circular Resolution, has appointed Mr. Sanjay Kumar, Company Secretary in Practice (FCS No. 9211 and CP No. 7027), as the Scrutinizer (hereinafter referred as the "Scrutinizer") on Wednesday, March 31, 2025, for conducting the Postal Ballot and e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner and in accordance with the provisions of the Act and the rules made thereunder.

In compliance with the provisions of Sections 108, 110 and other applicable provisions of the Act, read with (i) Rule 20 and Rule 22 of the Rules, as amended; (ii) Regulation 44 of the SEBI Listing Regulations (iii) the Secretarial Standards SS-2 and (iv) MCA Circulars, the Company has provided Remote e-Voting facility to its Members to enable them to cast their votes electronically and submitting the Postal Ballot Form physically also. For this purpose, the Company has engaged the services of National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL") as the agency to provide Remote e-Voting facility. The instructions for Remote e-Voting forms part of this Postal Ballot Notice.

The Postal Ballot Notice is being sent by electronic mode, to those Members whose email addresses are registered with the Company/ Depositories, in accordance with the aforesaid MCA and SEBI Circulars and physical copy of the Postal Ballot Notice along with Postal Ballot form and pre-paid business reply envelope is being sent to the Members whose email addresses are not registered with the Company for this Postal Ballot process.
